HALLS AND MEETING ROOMS

The Trinity Centre offers a warm welcome to all that visit and work here. A range of businesses and other organisations regularly use the Trinity Centre including HMRC, Be A Friend, TED and many others.

The Hall and Kitchen are available to hire for private parties when available.

The Chapel is also used for Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals throughout the year.

FOYER

On entry the Foyer provides a welcoming "meet and greet" area that can be used by all users of the centre.

ROOM HIRE

The Centre offers excellent rooms and facilities for businesses, voluntary groups or individuals, either full time or to hire on occasions. We offer free Wi-Fi access, a lift for disabled access, good refreshment and buffet services, a full working kitchen and kitchenette.

The main hall, kitchen and worship area are all accessed from the foyer, as are the stairs and lift to the first floor rooms.

MAIN HALL

The Main Hall is a well-lit, octagonal room which can be used by up to 120 people for receptions, parties, dances, training, concerts, lectures or conferences, and by up to 100 for a sit-down meal. We can provide staging for concerts and the hall is wired for sound with microphone points and an amplification system.

KITCHEN

The Kitchen is fully equipped with crockery, cutlery, cooking facilities and a dishwasher. It can be booked by customers for their own use or is suitable for use by outside caterers.

WORSHIP SPACE

The Worship Space is available for concerts or similar events and has seating for 100.

FIRST FLOOR

There are three meeting rooms and a kitchenette. The rooms on the first floor are suitable for smaller meetings, discussions and interviews. A kitchenette with tea and coffee-making facilities is available to all users.

MEETING ROOMS

Room 1 will accommodate up to 18 people boardroom style but can accommodate more used as a conference room or workshop space.

Room 3 will accommodate up to 12 people boardroom style, but can accommodate more in an alternative layout.

Room 4 has sofas and armchairs and is suitable for up to 12 people but is only available in the evenings and at weekends.
